

Boarding Policy

We provide a fun, clean, and safe environment for dogs and cats to receive lots of love and attention while they board with us. Pets can be examined by our Doctors and our veterinary technicians on a regular basis if needed. They can be bathed or fully groomed after they stay with us, so they go home smelling good and looking good.

Reservations

- We have limited space so boarding is for clients and patients of Indian Head Animal Hospital only. Reservations are necessary, especially during holidays.
 - **Pets are admitted/discharged during hospital hours.**
 - Monday and Tuesday: 8:30 AM to 7:30 PM
 - Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday: 8:30 AM to 5:30 PM.
 - Saturday: 8:30 AM to 3:30 PM.
 - The kennel is closed on Sunday.
 - The kennel is closed or has reduced hours on some federally observed Holidays.
 - Admitting or releasing your pet outside our regular hours can usually be arranged by appointment for an after hours fee of \$50.00 per pet.
- If your pet needs to stay longer than expected, please notify us as soon as possible so proper arrangements can be made.

Dogs must be current on the following:

- Annual Wellness Exam with one of our Doctors.
- Distemper, Hepatitis, Para influenza & Parvovirus
- Bordetella (kennel cough)
- Rabies.

Cats must be current on the following:

- Annual Wellness Exam with one of our Doctors.
- Distemper, Rhinotracheitis & Calici
- Rabies.

Care

- Dogs enjoy regular indoor exercise; individual outside walks area available at an extra charge.
- Pets are fed once a day, extra feedings can be arranged at an extra charge. We will be happy to feed your pet any diet you provide at no additional cost.
- Please let us know of any medical conditions in your pet's history and bring any needed medication with instructions.
- Geriatric, Diabetic or other pets with special needs will be examined as needed per Doctor's orders.
- Any pet harboring internal (intestinal parasites) or external parasites (fleas, ticks, lice, mites) will be treated at the owner's expense.
- Keeping fewer pets allows us to give each and everyone one of them the attention and loving care they need and deserve!

Peace Of Mind

Indian Head Animal Hospital operates continuously during power outages. We installed an industrial generator large enough to operate the entire hospital. We are available to serve your emergency needs and those of your neighbors and their pets everyday regardless of the weather or community emergencies.

Emergencies

In case of an emergency we will attempt to contact you, but reserve the right to administer immediate care to safeguard your pet's health and safety. **Any pet requiring medical attention will be treated at the owner's expense.** Please be sure to leave us a telephone number where you or a friend can be reached anytime.

How we calculate the boarding days

- The day of arrival is the first day of boarding.
- When your pet is picked-up during regular hours, the boarding fee is waived for the day of departure
- Two-day minimum for boarding

Items left with your pet

We cannot ensure the return of items left with your pet. Please take collars and leashes with you. You may leave a blanket or a toy, with the understanding that you may not get it back.
